2009 Foundation Events in Review

The Medicine Lake Honker Foundation had several fundraising opportunities in 2009.

The Second Annual Member Event was held on Saturday, March 28th at the Medicine Lake Firehall.

Approximately 65 people attended Gy Salvevold of Culbertson entertained on the piano. An "I Love Lucy" episode entitled "Lucy's Italian Movie" was shown, and Kathleen Waller presented a slide show representing the past and present graduates of Medicine Lake High school.

In addition to the many door prizes given throughout the night, \$1,870.50 was taken in from the 24 silent auction items. David Nelson of Medicine

Lake was the winner of the main door prize.

On September 12th, Stockman Bank of Plentywood generously hosted a tailgate event for the Medicine Lake Park and Pool Board and the Medicine Lake Honker Foundation during the Homecoming football game.. The foundation's share of the proceeds was \$824.85.

The Medicine Lake Honker Foundation held a Golf Ball Race later the same day. The foundation sold 200 balls for \$10 each and paid out to the top three winners.

Buckets of balls were tossed down a sloping sidewalk at the firehall in a V-shaped course of boards. Four heats of 50 balls were

released, and the first three balls to reach the point from each of those heats went to compete in the finals.

In the final round, Marial Hovet took the first place prize of \$300, Don Delorme took the second \$150 prize, and Norma Paulson was the third place winner of \$50. About 30 spectators came downtown to cheer on their golf balls.

Unfortunately, due to a lack of referees and players an alumni tournament was not held over the Christmas break.

Honker Foundation Awards Grants in 2009

The Medicine Lake Honker Foundation held their annual grant award ceremony on Tuesday, October 27th in the gymnasium of the Medicine Lake School. Four grant awards were given.

Ginny Bjorge's Business Department received an award for the Word IT! Software program, which contains activities that will reinforce the MS Word instruction already taught in the classroom. The text of this program focuses on "real world" scenarios in MS Word. This software will benefit 5th and 6th grade Keyboarding students as well as the Computer 9 students. The amount of funds for this software was \$243.80 .

Cathy Engstrom's 5th and 6th grade classes received a grant for "Made for Trade-A Game of Early American Life," a series of three games which will be used to aid in the study of early Colonial life. The

games will allow the students to have a fun, hands-on experience of events during the Revolutionary War period. The amount of funds for this grant was \$96.84.

Nicole Beaudette received a grant award in the amount of \$50 to purchase a CD/cassette player for her elementary PE classes. She intends to teach a rhythm and dance unit to the younger kids and jitterbug and other dances to the upper elementary students. Miss Beaudette explained that the importance for this curriculum is to help children develop creative expression and music appreciation. She also adds that dance and rhythm provide muscular growth, coordination and many other skills.

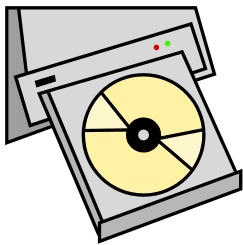
Marial Hovet received a grant award in the amount of \$379.72 for her Library/English/Reading department for the purchase of some audio books. This grant will benefit stu-

dents in grades 4-12. This award will assist students needing audio books in addition to books for an accelerated reading program. Mrs. Hovet hopes to improve students reading comprehension and increase reading for any student needing auditory presentation of books.

In addition to these grants, \$1,000 was received from Nemont of Scobey and \$1,000 was received from Sheridan Electric. This money was earmarked for a large 52" LCD flat screen HD television for the library. Students had been viewing political events and educational programs on a television situated on a traveling cart. This setup made it quite difficult for large groups of students to view programs.
